

SUMMARY OF SURVEY RESULTS

59 households stated that their children, or visiting children, use the Church Street play area and there is **overwhelming satisfaction with it** (52 are happy & 4 unhappy with it). 1 was unhappy because their children are too old for the equipment, 2 would prefer more equipment and 1 thinks it's too remote to allow their children to go unaccompanied. **The results show that it caters well for the younger age range.** Of those who don't use it, the main reason is their children are too old. The second reason is that it is too far away (this is mainly for households living at The Bank ... 3 households from The Bank stated the hill climb, together with the distance, is too much for them).

The number of households that think there is a need for more play equipment is about even. However, there is a **large majority against more equipment from households in Mount Pleasant** and a **large majority for more equipment from households in The Bank.**

There is a **large majority against play equipment on the village green from Mount Pleasant** households and a **small majority in favour from households in The Bank.** 23 households stated that their children, or visiting children, would use it but 7 stated that this would mean that they would use the Church Street play area less. **A clear majority of households with children, or visiting children, were against using the village green,** with a **small majority of households with no children in favour of it.**

To summarise, the survey indicates that the **majority of households in Mount Pleasant are happy with existing facilities** but that **households in The Bank would prefer a site closer to them.** This is underlined by the sites that the majority of households suggested in response to the question "If it is shown that there is a need for more play equipment, where would you suggest it should be located?" **The village hall is the most popular** (the adjacent football fields were suggested for older children).
